

Directions to Lakehurst Hall from Buckhorn

From the stoplights at the junction of the Buckhorn Rd and highway 36,

- turn right(coming south) or left (coming north) on to Lakehurst Rd and follow it making sure you bear right, and go past the Buckhorn Community Centre and the school. Watch for signs for Lakehurst Hall
- Continue until you pass the tip of Sandy Lake and immediately bear right onto Lakehurst Circle Rd a couple of miles to 979 Lakehurst C. Rd to meeting location.
- The Lakehurst Hall is on your left and it a cream colour building
