Bear Safety:

It is bear season again and we've already had a report of a bear event. The garbage box at the Sailing Club was visited by (presumably) a bear this week as someone had put food garbage in it. I am happy to report that the box survived. This does bring to the forefront that we need to be mindful of bears and do everything we can to discourage them from visiting our garbage bins. Roads & Maintenance:

There is a lot of sand on the roads from the winter and this can cause quite a cloud of dust as cars drive through the village. The City will be sending street sweeping equipment to tidy up our roads in approximately two weeks. The potholes on Henry St and Forest Rd have been reported to the City and we are hopeful to have them filled shortly. Light bulbs in the street lights have been replaced recently. If you see any that are burned out, please let us know and we will inform the City.

Leaf Dump:

The leaf dump, located on the north side of Irene Avenue with access near the top of 1st St, is open to all Sturgeon Pointers for disposal of leaves. This is one of the Trustee Lands on the Point that is maintained by SPA through your membership dues and donations. As you tackle your spring yard work please keep in mind that the only acceptable material for dumping in this location is leaves/pine needles. There have been reports of construction and other household waste being left at our dump; these materials are NOT acceptable. Any grass clippings, brush, downed branches, flower pots or other waste must be taken to one of the CoKL municipal landfills. (There are no tipping fees for brush and yard waste up to 3" in diameter.) We appreciate your help in keeping maintenance costs down at the leaf dump by ensuring that undesirable materials are directed accordingly.
