Now, the latest update on the Park.

The Village Office was torn down. We had planned to sell the building. We had 2 groups look at it, but we couldn't get it moved down Irene Ave., so we had to demolish it. We have just completed the laying of concrete. We now have a large multi-purpose court, which will be used for basketball, shuffleboard, and many other things. We also put a new layer of concrete on the foundation for the Pavilion. We are expecting that the Pavilion will be installed next week. Then, the final landscaping will be done.

Again, thanks to all of you who donated to the Park. It was wonderful to see how well it was used this summer. It has become a meeting place for children, their parents and grand- parents. We also expect next year to see a lot of basketball games being played by some of the bigger "folks", young and old. This is becoming a community center again.

Our next project is the Public Beach. This summer, we did a survey of needs for the Public Beach. We are now working on making recommendations and a plan for implementation. This will be funded by SPA and whatever grants that we may be able to get. There will be more on this in the spring.

We are pleased to announce that last year we had a record number of memberships sold – 260. I hope that we can continue to grow our membership, as these fees help us to fund the activities for the community and maintenance for our public lands.
